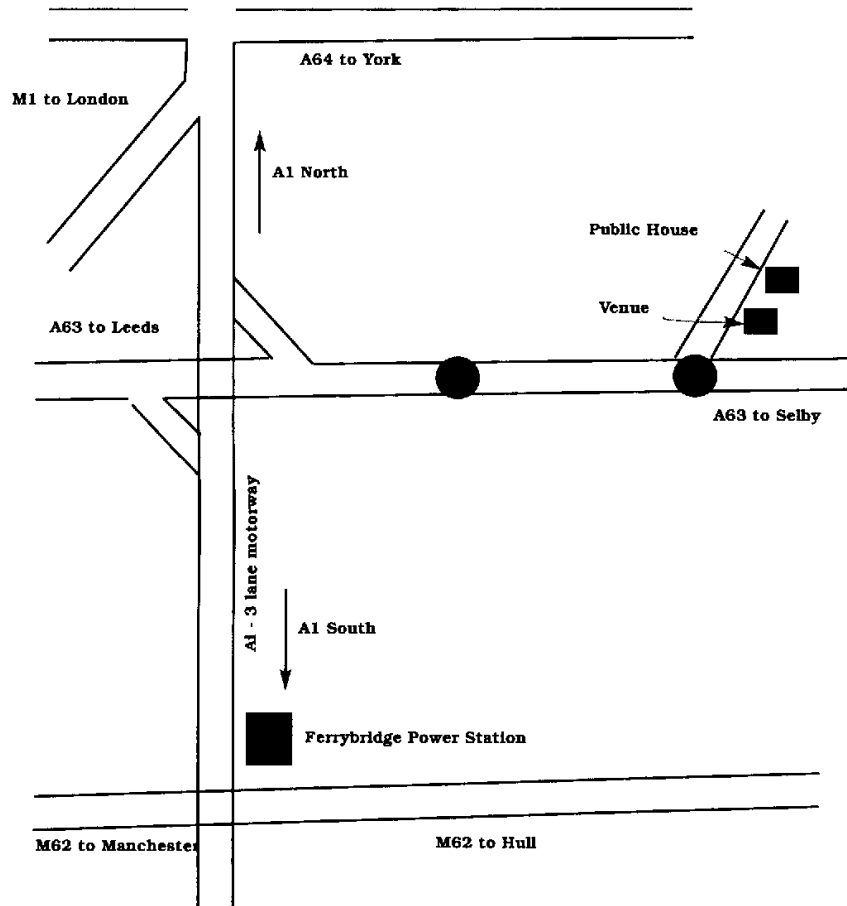


### Directions to Venue

From the South Take the A1 north bound under the M62 passed Ferrybridge Power Station to the next junction A63. Take the junction off and follow the A63 to Selby, follow road for approx 6 miles going over the first roundabout to the next one. Turn left in to Thorpe Willoughby. Venue is on the right with a large car park behind building. To enter car park go pass the venue and turn right at the Public House and first right again into car park.

From the North: Take the A1 south bound keeping to the left at M1 junction to A63 junction. Take the junction off and follow the A63 to Selby, follow road for approx. 6 miles going over the first roundabout to the next one. Turn left into Thorpe Willoughby. Venue is on the right with a large car park behind building. To enter car park go pass the venue and turn right at the Public House.

**PLEASE NOTE** The bank is now charging us for uncleared cheques: therefore we are forced to make a surcharge of £10.00 on top of the amount outstanding to any exhibitor whose cheque is returned to us by the bank.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.  
If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all. The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog. When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and/or any grooming waste at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event, including car and caravan parks and approaches.
20. The show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations. Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by these Rules and Regulations and is on the understanding only that entries are received.
21. The committee of the Show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the Show and remind exhibitors that groom products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition. (K.C.S.R. [F]).
22. Exhibitors/Handlers are responsible for clearing up and removing any loose hair or fouling from dogs in their charge or any other litter, whether from the car park, the exercise area or from any part of the venue.
23. Parents/Guardians please note, well behaved children are welcome but those in charge of children will be held responsible for their actions and any damage caused within the environs of the show.
24. Owners, Handlers, Exhibitors or any other person in charge of a dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must ensure at all times that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue including it environs, car parks and approaches.
25. All gangways must be kept clear.
26. The use of mobile phones in the vicinity of the judging rings is prohibited.
27. Car parking is FREE but the Club will not be responsible for any damaged or losses caused.

### DOG FOULING AND GROOMING WASTE

Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) and/or any grooming waste at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show will open at 9.30 a.m.
2. Dogs will be received until 12.00 noon and after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. Judging will commence at 10.30 a.m.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the show management.
6. **ENTRY FEES** : Members first entry per dog - £12.00 subsequent entries with same dog Non Members £15.00 first entry per dog, £1.00 each subsequent entry with the same dog, Special Beechrisse Memorial Award entry £1.00 per dog. £1.00. Not for Competition - £4.00 per dog. Catalogues £2.50 (pre-paid with entries), £3.00 on the day. Membership Fees:- £3.00 Single, £5.00 Joint,. Plus joining fee of £1.50 for new members..
7. Prize money for the Special Beechrisse Memorial Award only 1st £5.00; 2nd £3.00; 3rd £2.00
8. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
11. **Best Puppy in Show** Where a Best puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A Puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show respectively. Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy  
**Withdrawal from Other Competition** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed Classes prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.  
**Proviso** see proviso after Rule 12
12. **Best in Show** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which had competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show must not compete in any subsequent competition.  
**Withdrawal from Other Competition** Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.  
**Proviso for rules 11 & 12** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with permission of the Show Management.
14. No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
15. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licenced events.

**Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC classes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>**

**Best Breeder in Group 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.**

**Grand Final at dfs Crufts 2012**

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of four dogs of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows:

Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes 3 points  
Second place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes 2 points  
Third place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes 1 point  
Best Breeder in Group 4 points  
Second place Breeder in Group 3 points  
Third place Breeder in Group 2 points  
Fourth place Breeder in Group 1 point

The Breeders who have amassed a minimum of 25 points over a calendar year will qualify for the Final/Semi-final in the following year. It is not a requirement to withdraw from the competition upon reaching 25 points. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the dfs Crufts Final.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU BRING YOUR BREEDERS' BOOK TO THE SHOW AND THAT ONCE COMPLETED BY THE SHOW MANAGER, YOU KEEP THIS BOOK TO PRESENT TO THE RING STEWARDS AT THE APPROPRIATE TIME. Please remember that the 4 dogs entered should be all have been bred by the breeder/breeding partnership concerned and not by a combination of breeders/partnerships.
